



ADMINISTRATION OF MEDICATION

Parents are encouraged to give medication to their children at home whenever possible. The first 24 hours of a new prescription must be given to your child at home.

A designated staff member will administer prescription drugs to children, in accordance with provincial legislation provided that:

1. Parents provide written authorization, including the dosage and times any drug is to be given, and
2. Medication is in the original container, clearly labelled with the child's name, name of the drug, the dosage, the date of purchase and instructions for storage and administration of the drug.
3. Non-prescription or over-the-counter medications cannot be administered unless they are accompanied by written instructions from a medical doctor.
